### CONTENIDOS

The sentence. Classification. Constituent Structure: NP+VP. Constituent functions: subject + predicate. Structures of predication. Deep structures, surface and transformations.

The four basic grammatical structures. The structure of modification.

The Noun Phrase. The simple noun phrase. The complex noun phrase. Restrictive and non-restrictive modification.

Postmodification, by relative clauses, non-finite clauses (-ing, -d, and to infinitive), and prepositional phrases. The apposition. Nouns in groups.

Differences between the genitive and the of-structure. Premodification by adjectives, -ing and -ed participles, genitives and nouns.

The verb. Tense, aspect and mood. Classification of verbs: finite and non-finite.

The gerund and the infinitive. Verb patterns: Intransitive, transitive, ditransitive, complex-transitive and linking. The verb and its complementation: Patterns of verbs plus objects and/or complements.

Nominal clauses. Finite and non-finite clauses. Verbs plus adverbials.

Grammar within and beyond the sentence. The building of coherence and cohesion. Implication of the semantic content, lexical equivalence and syntactic devices. Formal and contextual links. (Inversion-fronting- cleft sentences- principle of end weight- emphasis- nominalizations)

The Adverbial clauses: finite and non-finite clauses. Semantic classification of adverbial clauses.

Phrasal, prepositional and phrasal prepositional verbs.
